The Venue Master Plan

The Competition venues will be located in five main clusters.

75 % of the venues will be placed in existing facilities.

The Olympic Village will be located in the Tor Vergata cluster

The IBC/MPC will be located close to the Foro Italico cluster

All the venues will be in a radius of 20 km from the city center

The main clusters will be connected by highway lines to the Olympic village minimizing transportation times and enhancing the athletes' living experience of the Eternal City.

The five clusters are:

- 1. Foro Italico (FI)**
- 2. Tor Vergata (TV)**
- 3. Fiera di Roma (FR)**
- 4. EUR (EUR)**
- 5. City center (CENTER)**

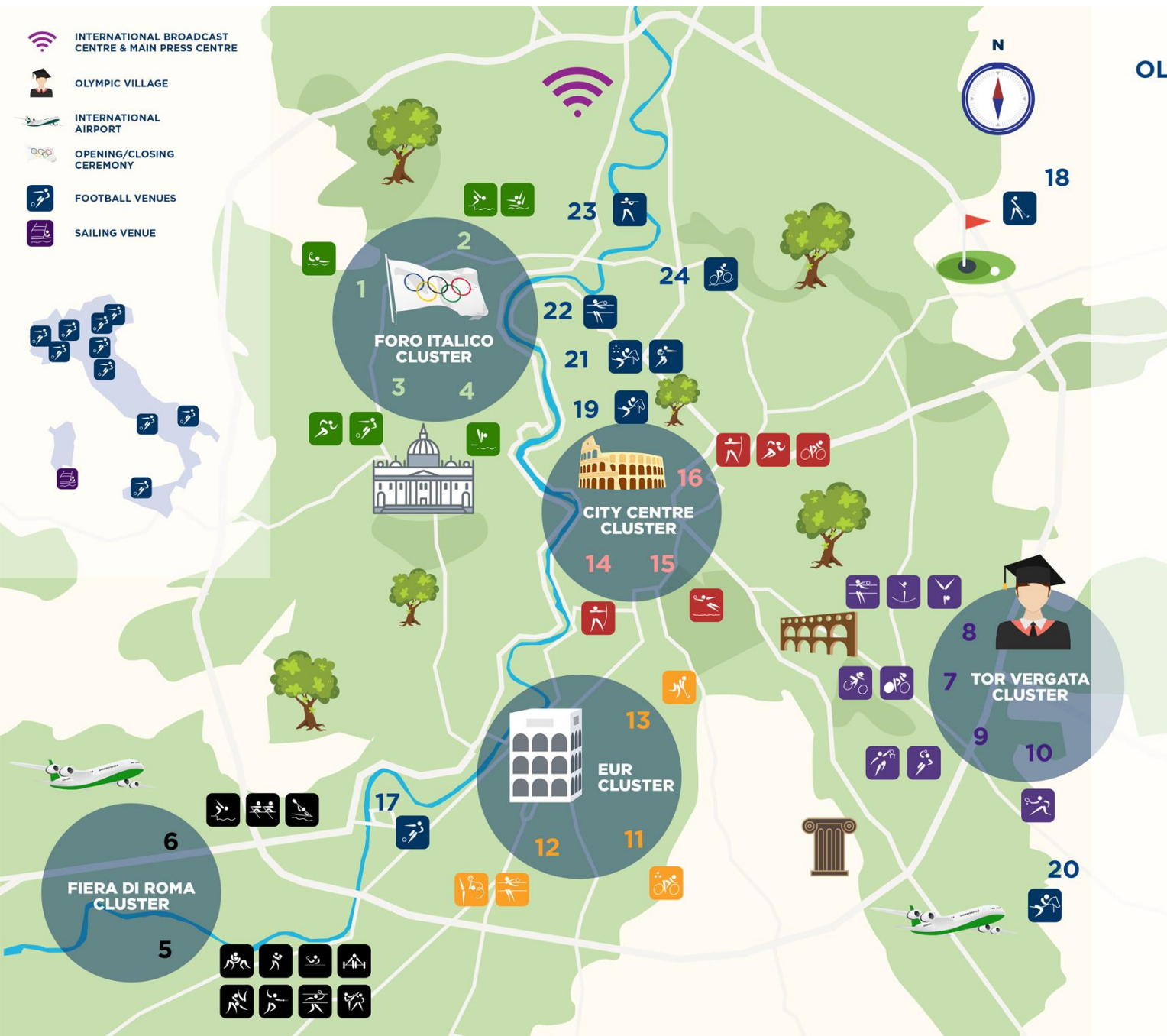

The torch, which is a positive symbol of life and light, and illuminates and dominates the darkness of selfishness and wars brings, in its long path, a message of peace

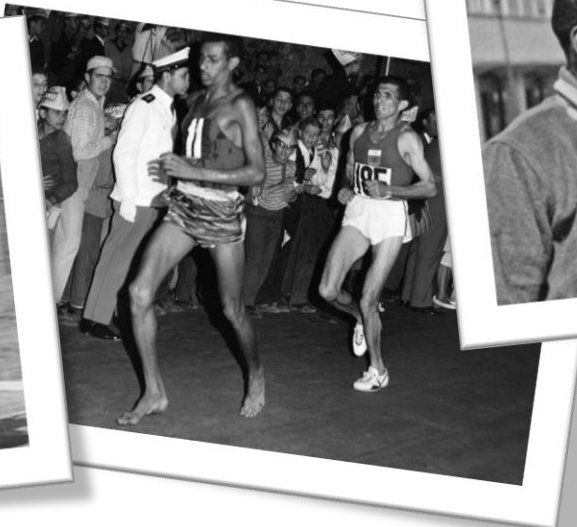

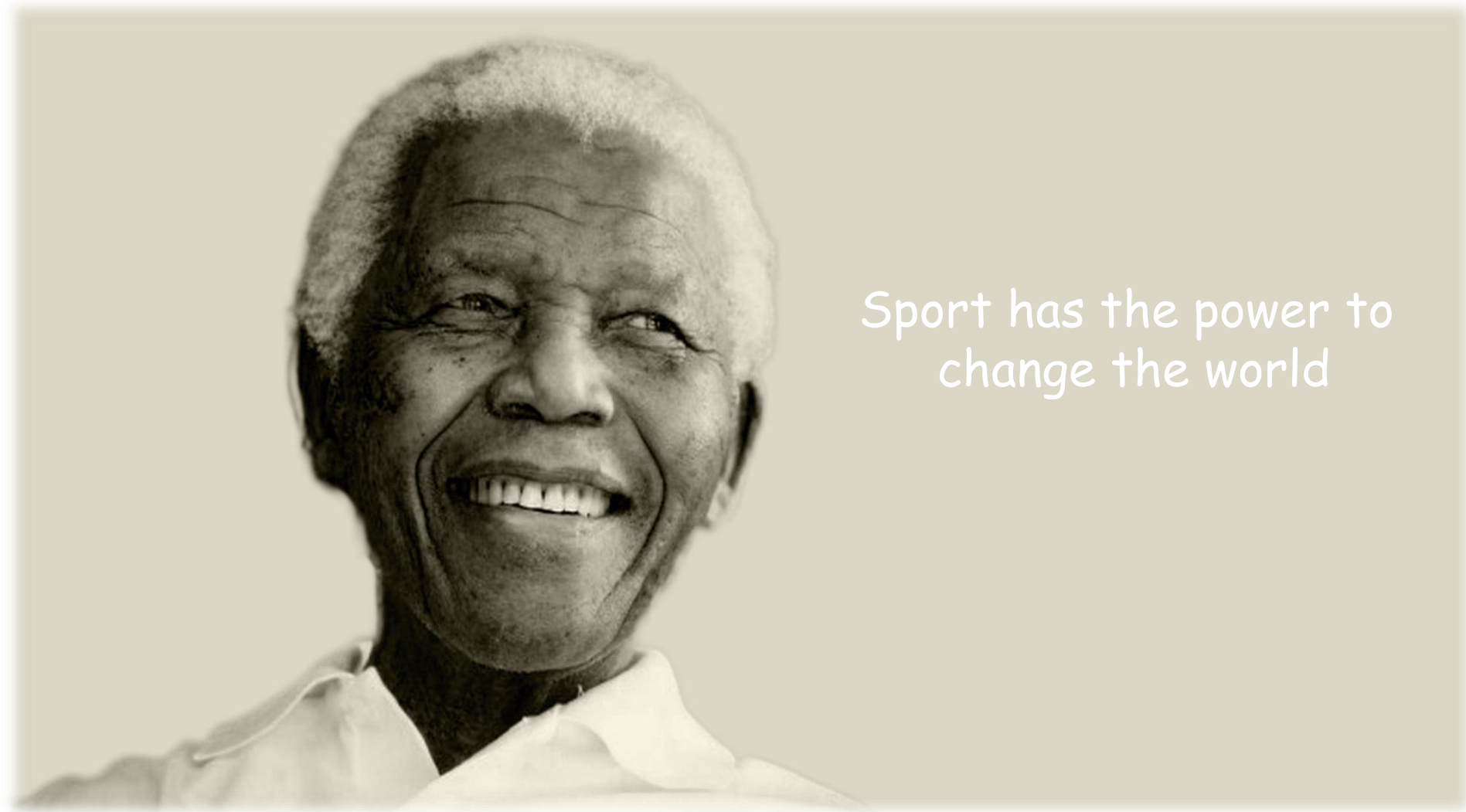
